Mentor Program

The Mentor Program is an on-going plan. New Town Clerks are able to request a Helper or Mentor. The Mentor and Mentee are matched as closely as possible (similar population, county, duties, etc.). Once the application has been processed we send letters to both parties and then they continue the relationship on their own. This year we had 8 requests from new Town Clerks, asking to be assigned a mentor. We had the information put on our Web Site and as the Mentors volunteer we are making the matches.
